- Great views of San Francisco Bay and San Francisco Airport
- Recreational amenity for walkers, cyclists and swimmers
- Partnership of San Mateo County Parks and San Mateo County Parks Foundation

TWO PROJECT PHASES

Planning Phase: July 2015 to May 2016

- San Mateo County Parks Foundation provided funds.
- Consultant will complete designs, plans, permits, and specifications.

Construction Phase: Fall 2016

- San Mateo County will pursue construction funds.
- San Mateo County will manage eastern promenade construction.
