Re: El Granada Blvd. Fuel Break Maintenance Project

Dear Property Owner:

As part of ongoing fuel reduction efforts, San Mateo County Parks Department is planning to conduct maintenance on an existing fuel break located between private residences on El Granada Boulevard and Quarry County Park. This maintenance work will include thinning and limbing shrubs to fire-safe standards, removing dead and dying eucalyptus trees on the edge of the fuel break, and mowing or weed-whipping grass and other herbaceous material. CALFIRE has provided a trained fuel's crew made up of wildland firefighters to help with this effort for four days. In order to conduct this work equipment such as chainsaws, a tree chipper and a low bed truck will be required. The CALFIRE crews will run this equipment throughout the course of the project, which is expected to occur April 22, 23, 25 and 26<sup>th</sup>. Work will be conducted between the hours of 8am and 5pm.
